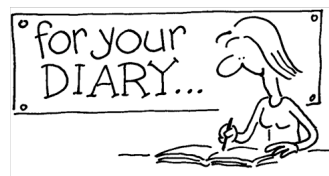

We exist as churches to lead people of all ages into a living relationship with Jesus Christ and to help each person to live every day *with* him and *for* him.

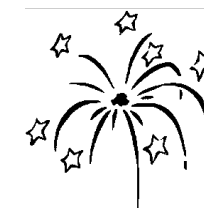
