THOUGHT FOR THE MONTH

*Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for
my path.*

Psalm 119: 105

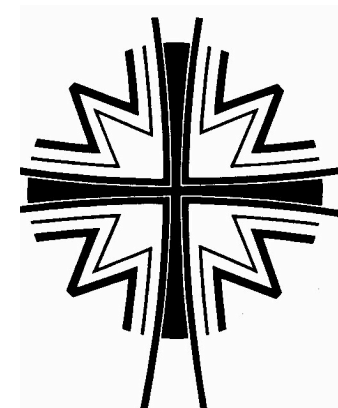
See the psalmist's picture. He has to travel. (Scripture regularly pictures life as a journey.) He was in the dark, unable to see the way to go and bound to get lost and hurt if he advanced blindly. (This pictures our natural ignorance of God's will for our lives, our inability to guess it and certainty in practice of missing it.) But a lamp has been handed to him. Now he can pick out the path before him, step by step, and stick to it, though darkness still surrounds him. (This pictures what God's word does for us, showing us how to live.) The psalmist's cry is one of *praise* that God glorifies his grace by giving men so precious a gift as his word; *thanks* because he knows how lost he was without it; *admonition* always to value God's word at its true worth; *testimony* to the fact that already in his experience it had proved its power; and *confidence* that this would continue.

Reflect: *God's word is a light in the darkness.*
